- 1) The Staff retired from Railway Service can only apply for the re-engagement.
- **2)** Medical fitness of the appropriate category must be obtained from the designated Railway medical authorities as per existing norms.
- **3)** Retired employees who were covered under the Safety Related Retirement Scheme (SRRS) or LARSGESS are **not eligible** for re-engagement.
- 4) Age Limit: Applicants must be below 64 years and 6 months of age as on the closing date of Notification.
